THE DEFEATED FOE

1 JN 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

We triumph because Jesus triumphed!

COL 2:15 *And* having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, **triumphing over them** in it.

HEB 10:23 Let us **hold fast the profession** of *our* faith without wavering; (for **he is faithful that promised**;)

In Christ men and women we are spiritually complete. (Col 2:10) We have been made part of the greatest Kingdom on earth.

COL 2:10 And **ye are complete in him**, which is the head of all principality and power:

The devil is a liar, we will be changed; "all things are become new".

2 COR 5:17 Therefore **if any man** *be* **in Christ**, *he is* **a new creature**: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

EPH 5:30 For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones.

We don't need redemption a second time. We already have it!

EPH 1:7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

We have all received of His fulness (completeness). We are filled with His grace.

JN 1:16 And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.

EPH 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, **that ye** might be filled with all the fulness of God.

Christ (who is our spiritual life) wants to indwell and fill us with God's fulness.

EPH 3:17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,

COL 1:27 To whom God would make known what *is* the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is **Christ in you**, the hope of glory:

COL 3:4 When Christ, *who is* **our life**, shall appear, then shall **ye also appear with him in glory**.

In Christ we have all we need. We have received wisdom, righteousness and more.

1 COR 1:30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

It's our responsibility to examine and monitor our own spiritual progress.

2 COR 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

MK 16:17 "And these signs shall follow them that believe; **In my name** shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; "

"In my name" This transfers the responsibility of the works to Christ. This in effect relieves the believer of a great burden of responsibility. In His name we possess everything we need to heal all manner of sickness and disease.

MAT 10:8 "Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give. " 9"Provide neither gold, nor silver, nor brass in your purses, "10"Nor scrip for *your* journey, neither two coats, neither shoes, nor yet staves: for the workman is worthy of his meat. "

Freely we have received of Him, **so freely give**. Because Christ has freely given, then we are able to freely give to the ministry. Everything will be provided as we step out by faith to do His work. If God be true, then let Him be true for you. We are either God's children or we are not. We either have a place in His Kingdom or we don't. "**The workman is worthy of His meat**".
