

THE GLORY OF GOD

Isa 6:3 And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, *is* the LORD of hosts: **the whole earth is full of his glory.**

Joh 8:12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, **I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.**

Joh 9:5 As long as I am in the world, **I am the light of the world.**

Rev 21:22 And **I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.**

Rev 21:23 And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: **for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.**

Mat 17:2 And was transfigured before them: and **his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.**

Exo 19:21 And the LORD said unto Moses, Go down, charge the people, **lest they break through unto the LORD to gaze,** and many of them perish.

Exo 19:22 **And let the priests also, which come near to the LORD, sanctify themselves,** lest the LORD break forth upon them.

Exo 33:19 And he said, **I will make all my goodness pass before thee,** and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before thee; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy.

Exo 33:20 And he said, **Thou canst not see my face: for there shall no man see me, and live.**

Isa 55:9 For *as* the heavens are higher than the earth, so are **my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.**

Ex 24:16 And the glory of the LORD abode upon mount Sinai,... 17 And the sight of the glory of the LORD *was* like devouring fire on the top of the mount in the eyes of the children of Israel.

ISA 28:5 In that day shall the LORD of hosts be for a **crown of glory,** and for a

diadem of beauty, unto the residue of his people,

ISA 35:2they shall see **the glory of the LORD, and the excellency of our God.**

ISA 6:1 In the year that king Uzziah died **I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple....**³ And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, *is* the LORD of hosts: **the whole earth is full of his glory.**

PSA 24:7 Lift up your heads, O ye gates; **and be ye lift up**, ye everlasting doors; **and the King of glory shall come in.** 8 **Who is this King of glory?** The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle. 9 Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift *them* up, ye everlasting doors; **and the King of glory shall come in.**

10 Who is this King of glory? **The LORD of hosts, he is the King of glory.** Selah.

The psalmist asked the question twice. “Who is the King of glory?” The answer is in (v.10) “the Lord of hosts.” God is looking from His glory to affect multitudes. He is thinking of nations. (Psa 2:8)

REV 21:25 And **the gates of it shall not be shut at all** by day: for there shall be no night there.

John vision of the gates: Rev 21:12-13, 15, 21, 25

ISA 60:1 Arise, shine; for **thy light is come**, and **the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.** 2 For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and **his glory shall be seen upon thee.**

Christ will be our inner light (glory) and this beacon of spiritual light shall be seen of all men. This wonderful anointing shall be resident in many and be the beacon that attracts the unbeliever to the Lord.

ISA 60:19 The sun shall be no more thy light by day; neither for brightness shall the moon give light unto thee: **but the LORD shall be unto thee an everlasting light, and thy God thy glory.**

ISA 62:3 Thou shalt also be a crown of glory in the hand of the LORD, and a royal diadem in the hand of thy God.

The Old Testament prophets often heard the voice of God coming from His glory. (Ex 3:4-6, 12; Isa 6:1,8; Rev 21:3, 5-8) It was their ability not only to enter into the heavenly realm by visions of His Glory, but once having experienced the Glory they were ushered even higher. Some were taken to the inner court (Eze 43:4) others saw the heavens open (Act 7:55; Rev 21:

EZE 3:12 Then the spirit took me up, and I heard behind me a voice of a great rushing, *saying*, **Blessed be the glory of the LORD from his place.**

EZE 3:23 Then I arose, and went forth into the plain: and, behold, **the glory of the LORD stood there, as the glory which I saw by the river of Chebar:** and I fell on my face.

ISA 43:4 And **the glory of the LORD came into the house** by the way of the gate whose prospect *is* toward the east. **5 So the spirit took me up, and brought me into the inner court; and, behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house.**

Ministry preparation is achieved by actively seeking God with a lifestyle of prayer with fasting. This will enhance ministers to enter into His glory realm. The glory realm is the visionary realm. Preachers must pay the price necessary to apprehend visionary capability. It can be the cutting edge to enhance prophetic platform effectiveness.

REV 15:8 And **the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God,** and from his power;

ACT 7:55 But he, **being full of the Holy Ghost,** looked up stedfastly into heaven, **and saw the glory of God,** and Jesus standing on the right hand of God, **56 And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God.**

ACT 26:13 At midday, O king, **I saw in the way a light from heaven, above the brightness of the sun, shining round about me** and them which journeyed with me. **14 And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me,**

On the road to Damascus Saul encountered Christ. This visitation of God's glory came with heaven's light and power which disabled Saul. (Act 26:13) He found himself on the ground with blinded eyes. He consequently recognized the power and authority of Jesus Christ.

REV 21:1 And **I saw a new heaven and a new earth**: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. 2 And **I John saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven**, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

There is so much preaching about God's kingdom and very little teaching about His glory. We should not limit the church to our teachings on heaven, by dismissing teachings about His glory. Glory minded spirit-filled believers will encounter His power, for His glory and power are linked. His glory will lift the people of God to new levels of anointing.

PSA 3:3 But thou, O LORD, *art* a shield for me; **my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.**

ZECH 2:5 For I, saith the LORD, will be unto her a wall of fire round about, **and will be the glory in the midst of her.**
